PCG releases 50 endangered sea turtles in Naic, Cavite

NAIC, Cavite – The Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) and villagers released 50 newly-hatched sea turtles or "pawikan" into the waters of Barangay Labac in Naic, Cavite on Thursday afternoon.

The sea turtles, identified as endangered marine species, were released after personnel of the PCG National Capital Region - Central Luzon coordinated with the local government unit of Barangay Labac.

Lt. Commander Michael Encina, PCG-Cavite Station commander, said their office has a "thrust for a diverse ecosystem and they were glad to witness the young sea turtle's release to their natural habitat."

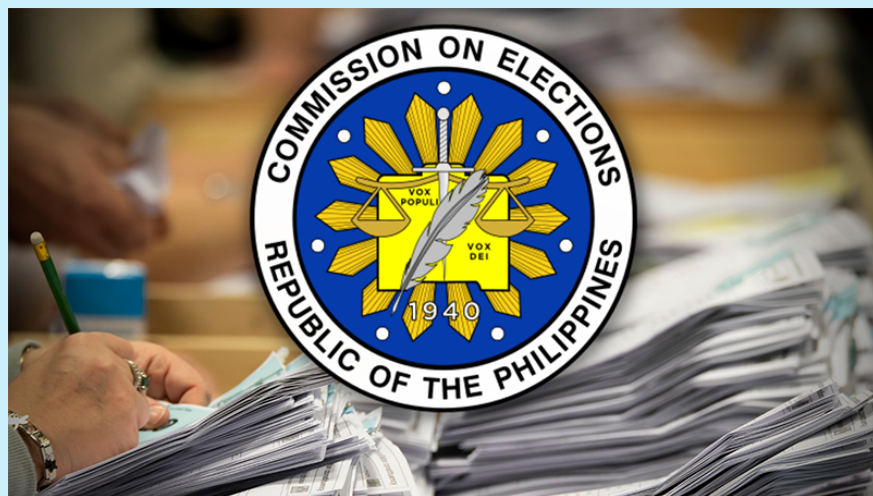
"It is the intent of the Philippine Coast Guard to enrich the marine biodiversity by involving our local government units and the coastal community through continuous and proactive marine environmental protection activities and vigorous campaigns participated primarily by our people," Encina said in a phone interview Friday morning.

The released hatchlings were incubated and protected by Barangay Labac's Nesting Facility.

Comelec starts delivery of supplies for Cavite special polls

The Commission on Elections (Comelec) on Tuesday started the delivery of poll paraphernalia and other supplies to be used in the special elections in the seventh legislative district of Cavite province on Feb. 25.



"Election forms, supplies, and paraphernalia, including official ballots, as well as all automated elections system-related equipment will already be deployed to the provincial hub," said Comelec spokesperson John Rex Laudiangco in a statement.

He added that the deployment of poll supplies will run until Friday.

A total of 355,184 official ballots along with 5,538 final testing and sealing (FTS) ballots have been printed for the special polls.

On the other hand, 426 vote counting machines along with the

same number of backup units will be used for the special polls.

The simultaneous FTS will be held on Feb. 19.

The Cavite police shall provide security escorts from the Comelec's warehouse in Santa Rosa City, La-

Municipalities from 2nd District of Batangas undergo WACS training

Municipalities of Lobo, Mabini, San Luis, San Pascual, and Tingloy, all from the 2nd District of Batangas, underwent a training on conducting Waste Analysis and Characterization Study (WACS) held at Brgy. Bagalangit, Mabini, Batangas, Feb. 8-9.



The Department of Science and Technology (DOST)-Batangas and the DOST Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI) conducted the two-day training in response to the call for science and technology-based intervention from the Office of Congresswoman Gerville "Jinky Bitrics" Luistro, 2nd District of Batangas Representative, to improve solid waste management in the second district.

Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officers (MENRO), Mar-

ket Administrators, and Vendors' Association Presidents from the five municipalities were the participants of the training. The participants were trained on the use of a simplified method of conducting WACS as an essential input in the preparation of their respective local government units' (LGUs) ten-year solid waste management plans in compliance with Republic Act (RA) 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000.

Technical experts from DOST-ITDI facili-

tated the training, which was divided into lectures and workshops. Dr. Myra L. Tansengco, Supervising Science Research Specialist, presented the basics of WACS, WACS procedures, WACS worksheets for non-households, initial planning, and formation of the WACS team. Mr. David Herrera, Senior Science Research Specialist, discussed the salient features of RA 9003 and the stratification classification of waste generators and facilitated the actual WACS dry-run.



Meanwhile, Ms. Maria Theresa C. Artuz, Science Research Specialist II, presented the health and safety guidelines for conducting WACS and

the preparation of the WACS plan. To put into actual use all the principles discussed, Engr. Joven R. Barcelo, Science Research Specialist I,

shared the sample size determination, worksheet preparation, end-of-pipe WACS, dry-run data, and facilitated the workshop on WACS



worksheets for households. Various technologies for solid waste management developed by DOST-ITDI were also covered during the training.

According to the technical experts, the basic function of WACS is to provide baseline information for the LGUs' monitoring and performance evaluation of solid waste management programs and activities. Hence, data from WACS can be used in setting

targets and identifying appropriate programs and strategies for the specific needs of LGUs.

Participants were asked to submit a WACS plan as training outputs. Cong. Luistro thanked DOST for conducting this training, which according to her, is essential to every LGU in formulating strategies, programs, projects, and activities that would improve their solid waste management.

LTO at the forefront of digital operations

It looks like the time of setting aside a whole day just to register motor vehicles and renew driver's licenses will soon be history.

On Feb. 14, the Land Transportation Office (LTO) launched a program for the online renewal of vehicle registration.

The onset of information technology and the continuing push of President Marcos to encourage government agencies to make full use of digitalization are making an impact on making the lives of citizens a little easier. The initiative, started by former President Duterte, had the Department of Transportation, the mother agency of the LTO, as one of the active supporters of digitalization.

LTO Chief Jose Arturo Tugade said registration of vehicles could now be done via online through the Land Transportation Management System (LTMS) portal, a process that may take only five to 10 minutes to complete.

The same LTMS portal is used in the online renewal of driver's licenses, which was implemented by the land transport agency in 2022. It only requires the applicant to appear at the LTO office for the photo, medical tests and to review the license before it is printed.

The shift to online registration of vehicles will benefit the five million vehicle owners who have been renewing their registrations yearly. In the Philippines, the LTO requires registration renewal of cars every year after the first three-year validity of new vehicles. A hefty fine of as much as ₱10,000 is imposed for failure to do so.

Tugade said the program is part of the government's goal of making government transactions seamless so that vehicle owners need not spend the whole day renewing the registration of their vehicles.

"Through this scheme, private individuals, companies or organizations can now use the LTMS portal to renew the registration of their vehicles without the need to go to any of the agency's district offices," said Tugade.

The LTO said the online renewal of vehicle registration will only apply to plain or standard renewal transactions. Other requirements are – the private vehicle owner must have a registered LTMS portal account, and



the last renewal transaction was completed using LTMS. Before conducting the online renewal, the owner should acquire a Certificate of Coverage (COC) or insurance of their choice.

A step in the process will require the vehicle to be brought to the Private Motor Vehicle Inspection Center (PMVIC) and checked for road worthiness.

"Both the validated insurance and the MV inspection report (MVIR) will be electronically sent to the LTMS. Once all the requirements are met, the vehicle owner can log in to his or her LTMS Portal account and conduct the renewal

process, including online payment," said Tugade.

"With the MV registration online renewal, vehicle owners can do it in a month's time, at their own pace, and in the comfort of their homes or during their office break," he added.

The use of the internet and digital transactions in government agencies will save time and money for the public, and the people will feel that the government cares for them. We hope the use of information technology will soon include other government services.

No Premium Increase in 2023, PhilHealth Reiterates



The Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) on Thursday reiterated its commitment to provide financial relief to Filipinos in light of socio-economic challenges brought about by the Covid-19 pandemic as it recognized the need to review the current contribution schedule to make it more affordable to many of its Direct Contributors.

PhilHealth had previously affirmed compliance with President Ferdinand

R. Marcos, Jr.'s earlier directive to suspend this year's scheduled pre-

mium rate of 4.5% and income ceiling of P90,000.

"Siniseguro po ng PhilHealth na patuloy ninyo kaming magiging kabalikat sa pagsulong ng kalusugan para sa lahat.

Ngayong taon at sa mga susunod pa ay makakaasa po kayo sa patuloy

na pagbuti at paglawak ng mga benepisyo para sa mamamayang Filipino," PhilHealth Acting President and Chief Executive Officer Emmanuel

R. Ledesma, Jr. said. Ledesma remarked that with the suspension in this year's increase, the premium rate remains at 4% with income ceiling of P80,000. "A

separate Advisory will be issued to provide the guidelines implementing the said directive particularly for the direct contributors," he said.

Meanwhile, during the Senate Committee on Health hearing on amending Republic Act No. 11223 or the UHC Act, specifically on premium contributions, PhilHealth said it agrees to the proposals of setting fixed premium rates for some member categories especially in view of the guiding principles of the National Health Insurance Program on equity and social solidarity – particularly on risk sharing among all in-

come groups.

"These are just some of the provisions that PhilHealth is presently reviewing in support of improving the law," Ledesma said. "Regardless, we would like to assure the public that PhilHealth wants nothing but to serve the Filipino with benefits that are of quality, responsive, and equitable in support of achieving Universal Health Care in this country.

We continue to call for the support in Congress and enjoin everyone to help PhilHealth be the program that we aim and envision it to be," the PhilHealth chief added.

Accordingly, the instant petition is filed for the divorce to be properly recognized in the Philippines and for such recognition to be duly annotated in the Civil Registry and corresponding entries as to the civil status of the petitioner to be accordingly cancelled or corrected.

Finding the petition sufficient in form and substance, let the petition be set for hearing on **April 12, 2023 @ 9:30 in the morning**. All those interested parties are cited to appear and show cause why it should not be granted.

Let this order be published once a week for three consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Cavite.

Furnish the Office of the Solicitor General, the Local Civil Registrar of Bacoor, Cavite, and the Philippine Statistics Authority with a copy of the Petition and this Order.

CAVITEX and CALAX are declared by the DOTr through their Department Order (D.O) 2007-15 DESIGNATION AND DECLARATION OF ALL EXPRESSWAYS AS LIMITED ACCESS FACILITIES, and as such will only allow Motorcycles 400cc and above.

Expressways are high-speed road facilities, and we aim for all our motorists to be safe while using our network of toll roads, we encourage them to follow the signs and speed limits," said Mr. Raul L. Ignacio, President of MPT South.

The toll road company advised below 400cc motorcycle riders to use the 'two-wheeler' or 'motorcycle' mode when using a GPS navigation app. This will avoid di-

recting the rider passing through different expressways going to the destination.

"Aside from intensifying our security and traffic operations, we will continue to reach and educate drivers thru our 'Drayberks' road safety seminar that will roll out in selected communities of NCR and CALABARZON this Q1 of 2023," Ignacio added.

MPT SOUTH REMINDS: BELOW 400CC MOTORCYCLES, STILL PROHIBITED ON EXPRESSWAYS

Metro Pacific Tollways South (MPT South), a subsidiary of Metro Pacific Tollways Corporation (MPTC), continues to remind motorists to obey the Limited Access Facility Act (Republic Act 2000) which prohibits the entry of motorcycles with engine displacement less than 400cc in expressways, including the Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX), its CAVITEX C5 Link Segment, and the Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX).

The reminder followed an increase in R.A. 2000 violations, particularly among below 400 cc motorcycles entering the high-speed road network CAVITEX in the first month of the year. From January 1 to January 31, 2023, a total of 273 motorcycle riders were intervened by the security patrol-

men in CAVITEX entry points — a 295% surge vs. the 69 riders recorded from the same period of the previous year. Despite the obvious and noticeable "Prohibited on Expressway" signages installed at every entry point, the majority, or 83% of those riders said that they got 'lost'.

"Motorcycle usage experienced an uptick in 2020 when our country succumbed to the Covid-19 pandemic, and we do recognize the benefits that this development has brought — both in ride-sharing and logistics services. A reminder to our motorcycle community that
