ORDER

Submitted for resolution is the Motion for Reconsideration filed by the applicant, on the decision of the Court denying the application.

It is noted that on October 25, 2019, the Court rendered a Decision denying the application for accreditation for failure to provide proof of compliance with Section 2(a) of PD 812 or the Decree on Legal and Judicial Deposits.

On December 11, 2019, applicant filed an Explanation with Motion to Reconsider the Decision dated October 25, 2019 alleging that it submitted a Certification issued by the National Library of the Philippines (NLP) in compliance with PD 812 but failed to secure a receiving copy. Applicant likewise attached in the said motion a copy of certification issued by Nina B. Fronda, Chief of Bibliographic Services Division of the NLP as well as several Order from different Regional Trial Courts granting their petition for accreditation. It likewise submitted another certification issued by Melody M.Madrid, Acting Chief of the Collection Development Division of the NLP to the effect that applicant deposited issues of the Pulso ng Makabagong Cavitenos with the library in compliance with PD 812.

In view of the compliance of the applicant with PD 812 the Decision dated October 25, 2019 is hereby reversed and set aside. The application of PMC Pulso ng Makabagong Cavitenos is hereby GRANTED. Accordingly, PMC ng Makabagong Cavitenos is allowed to participate in the raffle of the publication of legal and judicial notices for five (5) years commencing on this date unless sooner suspended or revoked.
